SHELTON STATE TERRIFIC TUESDAY CONCERT SERIES TO FEATURE NATS MUSICALE PERFORMANCES

Tuscaloosa, Alabama – Shelton State Community College’s Terrific Tuesday Concert Series will feature NATS Musicale performances on Tuesday, February 7 at 1:00 p.m. in the Alabama Power Recital Hall on the Martin Campus. Admission is free and open to the public.

On the weekend of February 17-18, Shelton State Community College’s voice students will travel to Birmingham Southern College to participate in the Alabama Chapter of The National Association of Teachers of Singing (ALANATS) auditions. During this weekend, voice students from the state of Alabama will be adjudicated by teachers of singing from all around the state. Singers are placed into categories according to their level of study and will sing for a panel of judges that will evaluate their performance. Those scoring the highest in the preliminary rounds will be passed along to semi-finals and finals, where winners will be selected by a popular vote of all participating voice instructors. On Tuesday, February 7, Terrific Tuesday will feature students from Shelton State Community College attending this event.

Shelton State’s Terrific Tuesday Concert Series is designed to showcase a variety of repertory styles. Weekly performances are offered by guest artists as well as Shelton State faculty and students.
