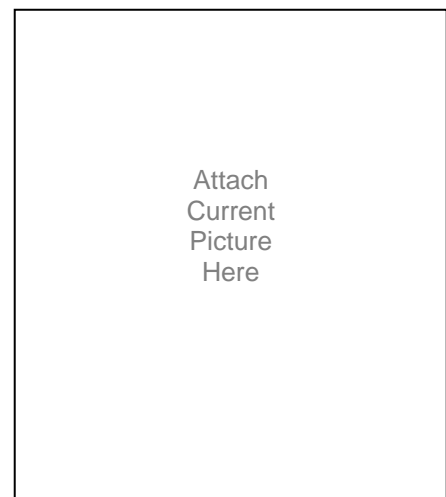

- (1) The completed Shelton State Community College Ambassador Program Application.
- (2) An official high school transcript including grades for 9<sup>th</sup> through the first semester of the 12<sup>th</sup> grade or college transcript, if currently enrolled at a college.
- (3) A resume indicating the applicant's experience in leadership activities.
- (4) Two letters of recommendation: one from a learning institution & one from a private sector.
- (5) A typed essay answering the following questions: "Why you would like to be an ambassador?" and "What do you feel you can contribute to the Ambassador organization?"

## Ambassador Information

**Who We Are:** The Ambassadors serve as the official hosts and hostesses for Shelton State Community College. Ambassadors are chosen from interested high school seniors and current Shelton State students each spring semester. Students in the Ambassador program are involved in the life of Shelton State beyond the classroom.

**What We Do:** Whether guiding tours of Shelton State's campuses for high school students, helping with fundraisers for Shelton State's Adopt-A-School partner, greeting the community at Shelton State Alumni Association functions, or working with service agencies in West Alabama, the Ambassadors always represent the college while serving the community. Working as an Ambassador is a great way to learn and practice leadership skills. Ambassadors also spend quality time in fellowship.

**What We Ask:** Ambassadors must be enrolled as full-time students as attend regularly scheduled meetings. In addition to attending regular business meetings, the Ambassadors serve a minimum of 35 service hours or a maximum of 80 service and leadership development hours during the fall and spring semesters, with at least half of the service hours completed at midterm of each semester. A monetary compensation will be provided to students who accept this honor. We are looking for **responsible** students who are willing to take a **leadership** role at Shelton State.

**How You Can Join Us:** There is a great deal of interest and a limited number of openings in the group each year. Students who complete and return an application must go through an interview process. Selection is based on leadership and service experience, academic performance, and personal qualities demonstrated through the interview process. Meeting the minimum requirements does not guarantee selection.
