SUMMER 2018 SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

Shelton State Community College offers competitive scholarships to qualified students who are **residents of the state of Alabama**. Applicants must be **high school seniors graduating in 2018, previous high school graduates, or GED recipients**. Meeting the minimum requirements does not guarantee a scholarship award. Scholarships are awarded based on availability of awards. Scholarship applications must be completed online via Award Spring. Check scholarships webpage for details. **Scholarship application deadline is March 1, 2018.**

Alabama Community College System policy requires that scholarship recipients be U.S. Citizens or resident aliens who meet Institutional requirements. Every applicant is required to submit an application for admission to the College and is encouraged to apply for federal financial aid. Application should be made for the academic year(s) in which the award will be provided. Application for federal aid may be made online at www.FAFSA.ed.gov. Shelton State's school

SUMMER STUDIES SCHOLARSHIPS

- One-time award
- Available only to students the summer following high school graduation
- Must have taken at least one class at Shelton State as dual enrolled or accelerated high school student by end of fall 2017
- Must have graduated high school with a diploma
- Cumulative high school GPA ≥ 2.5 after fall 2017
- 300-word (maximum) essay on educational goals
- Consideration of activities and honors
- Waives tuition and some fees for up to six hours in summer 2018

SOPHOMORE SUMMER STUDIES SCHOLARSHIPS

- One-time award
- Available only to currently enrolled Shelton State students
- Cumulative GPA ≥ 3.0 after fall 2017
- Must have completed at least 24 hours of coursework at Shelton State by end of fall 2017
- Selection based on academic coursework and references
- 300-word (maximum) essay on educational goals related to current program of study
- Waives tuition and some fees for up to six hours in summer 2018
