Automotive Technician

**Purpose: The Automotive Technician is responsible for inspection, repair and diagnostic services. You will work on computer systems diagnosis, electrical troubleshooting, and mechanical/electrical component replacement. You must have the ability to explain technical diagnoses and needed repairs to non-mechanical individuals which may include other associates and customers.**

**Responsibilities:**

- Perform work specified repair orders with efficiency and in accordance with OEM standards
- Diagnose and repair vehicle automotive systems including engine, transmission, electrical, steering, suspension, brake, air conditioning, etc. to specification
- Explain mechanical diagnoses and required repairs in a non-technical manner to management and customers
- Continuously learn new technical information and techniques in formal training sessions in order to stay abreast with rapidly changing technology
- Ability to read and interpret work instructions
- Proficiency with power tools for assembly and disassembly of parts
- Inspect and test new vehicles and recording findings so that necessary repairs can be made
- Work will be performed in a manufacturing facility and can include working on the assembly line
- Other duties as assigned and required by management
