JOB SUMMARY:

The Welder- Fitter is responsible for using MIG welding equipment to manufacture parts and assemblies as required, meeting defined production schedules.

JOB DUTIES:

- Builds welded assemblies for new products and changes to existing products per engineering documents and established production standards.
- Operates other necessary equipment and performs tasks necessary to complete parts to specifications.
- Prepares and sets up necessary tools and equipment for welding jobs.
- Arranges parts for welding and staging processes.
- Proposes potential quality or productivity enhancements i.e. continual improvements
- Supplies quality parts & assemblies from jigs & fixtures.
- Reviews finished assemblies & parts to ensure accuracy against drawings & BOMs.
- Reports fabrication issues and assist in resolutions as required.
- Participates in and attends cross functional meetings as required.
- Supports the Quality Assurance department with respect to jig & fixture evaluation.
- Ensures compliance in all safety, health, and environmental regulations, policies and procedures for a goal of zero incidents and injuries.
- Performs additional duties as required.

- Familiarity with the use of Jigs & fixtures
- Must be able to perform simple computer entry for time keeping purposes
- Ability to read engineering drawings
