**GRANT APPLICANT REQUIREMENTS**

- Applicants must have a high school diploma or GED.
- Applicant must be female.
- Applicant must demonstrate financial need.
- Applicant must complete Pharmacy Technician Registration through the Pharmacy Technician Certification Board.

**COURSE TOPICS**

- Medical terminology specific to the pharmacy
- Reading and interpreting prescriptions
- Defining drugs by generic and name brand
- Dosage calculations
- I.V. flow rates
- Drug compounding
- Dose conversions
- Dispensing of prescriptions
- Inventory control
- Billing reimbursement

To be eligible for the clinical rotation, students must successfully complete the 50 hour program, submit to a thorough background check and drug screening, and meet other requirements.

Other requirements include completion of 80 hour clinical externship, attendance at a 20 hour test prep course and a 20 hour math refresher course, and completion of the pharmacy technician exam.

# PHARMACY TECHNICIAN GRANT PROGRAM

Free to qualified students, this comprehensive online course will prepare students to enter the pharmacy field and to take the Pharmacy Technician Certification Board (PTCB) Exam. Students train online to work in hospitals, home infusion pharmacies, community pharmacies, and other health care settings under the supervision of a registered pharmacist.
