COURSE TOPICS

- CPT (Introduction, guidelines, evaluation, and management)
- Specialty fields (Surgery, radiology, and laboratory)
- ICD-10 (Introduction and guidelines)
- Basic claims processes for medical insurance
- Third party reimbursements
- Location of service and codes using manuals (CPT, ICD-10, and HCPCS)

Note: After obtaining practical work experience (six months to two years), students who complete this course could be qualified to sit for the American Academy of Professional Coders (AAPC); Certified Professional Coder Exam (CPC or CPC-H Apprentice); the American Health Information Association (AHIMA) Certified Coding Associate (CCA) exam; and/or other National Certification Exams.
