Summer 2023 Institutional Scholarships

Shelton State Community College offers competitive scholarships to qualified students who are **residents of the state of Alabama**. Scholarships are awarded based on availability of awards. Meeting the minimum requirements does not guarantee a scholarship award. Scholarship applications must be completed online via AwardSpring. Visit the scholarships webpage for details. **The scholarship application deadline is March 1, 2023.** Alabama Community College System policy states that any student who is awarded institutional scholarship hours is limited to a total of eighty-two award hours. Scholarships will apply to tuition only. **The student will be responsible for all fees.**

Alabama Community College System policy also requires that scholarship recipients be U.S. citizens or resident aliens who meet institutional requirements. Every applicant is required to submit an application for admission to the College and an application for federal financial aid. Students should apply for the academic year(s) in which the award will be provided. Students must apply for federal financial aid online at <https://studentaid.ed.gov/sa/fafsa>. Shelton State's school code is 005691.

SUMMER STUDIES SCHOLARSHIP	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Applicants must be 2023 high school graduates who have graduated with a high school diploma. • The unweighted high school GPA must be greater than or equal to 2.5 at the end of fall 2022. • Applicants must have completed at least one class at Shelton State as a dual or accelerated high school student by the end of fall 2022. • The award is valued at \$750 for the summer 2023 term only. • The award waives tuition only. <u>The student will be responsible for all fees.</u> • The selection is based on academic coursework, activities, and honors. • Students may receive this award one time only.
SOPHOMORE SUMMER STUDIES SCHOLARSHIP	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Applicants must be currently enrolled Shelton State students. • The institutional GPA must be greater than or equal to 2.5 at the end of fall 2022. • Applicants must have completed at least twenty-four hours of coursework at Shelton State by the end of fall 2022. • The award is valued at \$750 for the summer 2023 term only. • The award waives tuition only. <u>The student will be responsible for all fees.</u> • Selection is based on academic coursework. • Students may receive this award one time only.

Athletic scholarships are awarded based on try-outs or demonstrated ability to perform at the intercollegiate level.
