*Additional costs include health immunizations and exam fees. Health immunization costs vary; the fee for state pharmacy registration (including background check) is \$104; the fee for the Certified Pharmacy Technician Exam is \$129.



This comprehensive course will prepare students to enter the pharmacy field and to take the Pharmacy Technician Certification Board (PTCB) Exam. Students train online to work in hospitals, home infusion pharmacies, community pharmacies, and other health care settings under the supervision of a registered pharmacist.

The clinical externship is required for program completion.
