# Student Checklist for Dual Enrollment Registration 

## Checklist for First Time Dual Enrollment Student

$\qquad$ Met the following requirements to participate in Dual Enrollment:

- Current high school transcript
- A minimum 2.0 cumulative, unweighted GPA for most technical courses and a 2.5 GPA for academic \& CIS, RPT, \& HIT courses
- Current enrollment in $10^{\text {th }}, 11^{\text {th }}$, or $12^{\text {th }}$ grade in an eligible high school
- Selected courses must be at or above the 100 level.
- Met all prerequisite requirements as listed in the SSCC course catalog. Students must submit appropriate ACT, SAT, or college Accuplacer placement scores.

Submit the Shelton State admission application for the appropriate semester. Note: Select the Application Type: Dual Enrollment
$\qquad$ Submit the Dual Enrollment Approval Form.

- New students must upload an updated copy of the high school transcript.
- If requesting a math or english course, upload qualifying ACT scores that include the student's full name, test date(month/year), and regular test scores (NO superscores will be accepted). View the chart below for required placement scores.
- Student signatures are required after the form is submitted. Check the student email to sign. Completed Accuplacer Placement Test

Note: Take the Accuplacer only if student is taking math or english course and does not have the qualifying ACT/SAT scores.

## Checklist for Returning Dual Enrollment Student

Returning students are not automatically reenrolled and must resubmit the dual enrollment approval form each semester. All steps below must be completed to be re-enrolled. If a student does not take a dual course for two consecutive terms, the student must reapply to the college as a dual enrollment student.
$\qquad$ Submit the Dual Enrollment Approval Form.

- If requesting a math or english course, upload qualifying ACT scores that include the student's full name, test date(month/year), and regular test scores (NO superscores will be accepted). View the chart below for required placement scores.
- Student signatures are required after the form is submitted. Check the student email to sign.
