

Advanced Placement (AP): Advanced Placement credit may be awarded by Snead State Community College to a student who has obtained a score of 3 or higher on the College Board Advanced Placement Examination. Official scores must be sent from the College Board to the Office of Student Services. **Students must complete at least 25% of semester credit hours of program requirements at SSCC in order to earn a degree at Snead State Community College. Credit awarded through transfer or non-traditional means shall not be included in the 25% requirement.**

Acceptance of non-traditional credit by Snead State does not guarantee other institutions will accept or honor the credit. Students are encouraged to contact their intended transfer school to determine if the credits will transfer.
