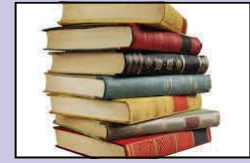

Medical Assistance

- ◆ Dial **911** for any emergency.
- ◆ Students can go to DCH Medical Center, Tuscaloosa or DCH Medical Center, Northport for medical services.
- ◆ DCH Health Systems can provide health services and referrals.
- ◆ A Sexual Assault Exam is available at either of the DCH Medical Centers. The exam includes preventive treatment for sexually transmitted infections, pregnancy and evidence collection. The exam is conducted by a Sexual Assault Nurse Examiner (SANE) who is a Registered Nurse with advanced training and certification in conducting sexual assault exams.

Emergency Systems

- ◆ Students may also dial 911 for 24/7 emergency services from the Tuscaloosa Police Department.

Advocacy and Support Services
