- A. Trips that are two or more continuous days and include overnight travel include a \$25 per night pay differential in the amount posted.
- B. The rates listed above are the maximum payments allowed regardless of the number of destinations within a trip or trips within an individual day. Absent extraordinary circumstances, drivers should not start a new overnight trip on the same date that another overnight trip concludes.
- C. Bus drivers are not allowed to work more than forty hours in any one work week and are not allowed to work more than 129 hours in any one month.
- D. A work week includes days worked from Sunday to Saturday in the same week. For purposes of this schedule a day begins at 12:00 a.m. and ends at 11:59 p.m.
- E. Any trip exceeding ten days will be paid based on the flat rate of \$275 per day and the additional \$25 per night pay differential.
